Texas Community Development Block Grant Program

The City of Slaton will hold a public hearing at 5:05 pm on June 8th, at Slaton City Hall in regard to the submission of a Downtown Revitalization Program (DRP) application for Texas Community Development Block Grant Program (TxCDBG) funding. The purpose of this meeting is to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the development of housing and community development needs, the amount of funding available, all eligible activities under the TxCDBG, the use of past TxCDBG funds, the estimated amount of funds proposed for activities that will meet the national objective of benefit to low and moderate income persons, and the plan to minimize displacement of persons and to assist persons displaced as a result of TxCDBG activities. The city encourages citizens to participate in the development of these applications and to submit their views and proposals regarding community development and housing needs. Citizens unable to attend this meeting may submit their views and proposals to Roger McKinney, City Manager, at City Hall. Persons with disabilities that wish to attend this meeting or individuals who require auxiliary aids or services for this meeting should contact City Hall at least two days before the meeting if assistance is needed so that appropriate arrangements can be made. The DRP application will be available for public review at City Hall at a date to be determined.
